Re: Call for expressions of interest – UK research opportunity for funded fellows in advanced cardiovascular magnetic resonance

Dr. Lewis' group at the University of Oxford Centre for Clinical Magnetic Resonance Research invites expressions of interest from international cardiology fellows for an up to two-year research fellowship.

The successful candidate will lead clinical investigations into spatially resolved energetic signatures in failing and recovering human hearts, combined with state-of-the-art tissue profiling.

This opportunity is ideal for cardiology fellows in training who already possess advanced knowledge of clinical cardiac MRI and aim to develop additional research skills in ultra-high field imaging and cardiac energetics. The Centre, renowned for training future leaders in cardiac MRI, provides comprehensive research facilities with necessary approvals and project funding in place.

Candidates will need secure their own salary funding for the duration through an appropriate exchange scheme (such as the DFG Walter Benjamin Programme, Jahresstipendien of the Deutsche Herzstiftung, or EACVI Training Grants) but will be supported to develop their application.

The position offers the chance to work within a productive research team, with access to cutting-edge technology and established research protocols.
